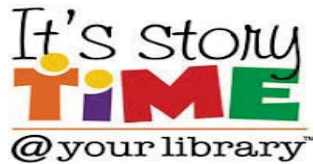

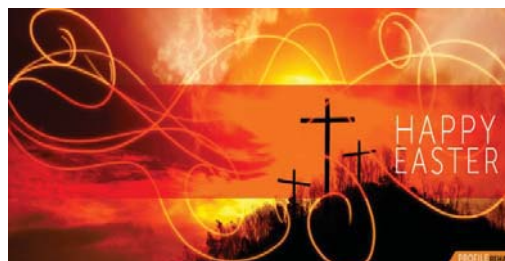

## Moving forward without moving out

**Accessing your home equity can help boost your retirement income, ease pressure on your pensions and investments, and help you stay put.**

In a recent survey of Canadian homeowners, only four in 10 respondents were confident they would have enough savings to maintain their lifestyle when they retire.
