The summary consolidated financial statements do not contain all the disclosures required by Canadian public sector accounting standards. Reading the summary consolidated financial statements and the auditors' report thereon, therefore, is not a substitute for reading the municipality's audited consolidated financial statements and the auditors' report thereon.

The Audited Financial Statements and Our Report Thereon

We expressed a qualified audit opinion on the audited consolidated financial statements in our report dated June 26, 2022.

Our qualified audit opinion is based on the fact that Recreation Boards derive revenue from various sources the completeness of which is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification.

Management's Responsibility for the Summary Consolidated Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of the summary consolidated financial statements in accordance with Canadian public sector accounting standards.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on whether the summary consolidated financial statements are a fair summary of the audited consolidated financial statements based on our procedures, which were conducted in accordance with Canadian Auditing Standard (CAS) 810, "Engagements to Report on Summary Financial Statements".

The external auditors have full and free access to the Council to discuss their audit and their findings as to the integrity of the municipality's financial reporting and the adequacy of the system of internal controls.
