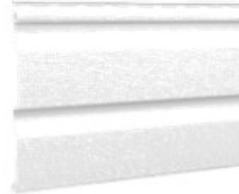

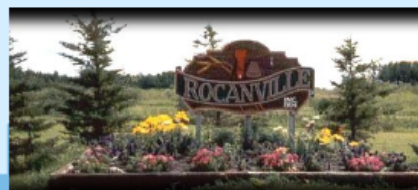

Our qualified audit opinion is based on the fact that Recreation Boards derive revenue from various sources the completeness of which is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification.

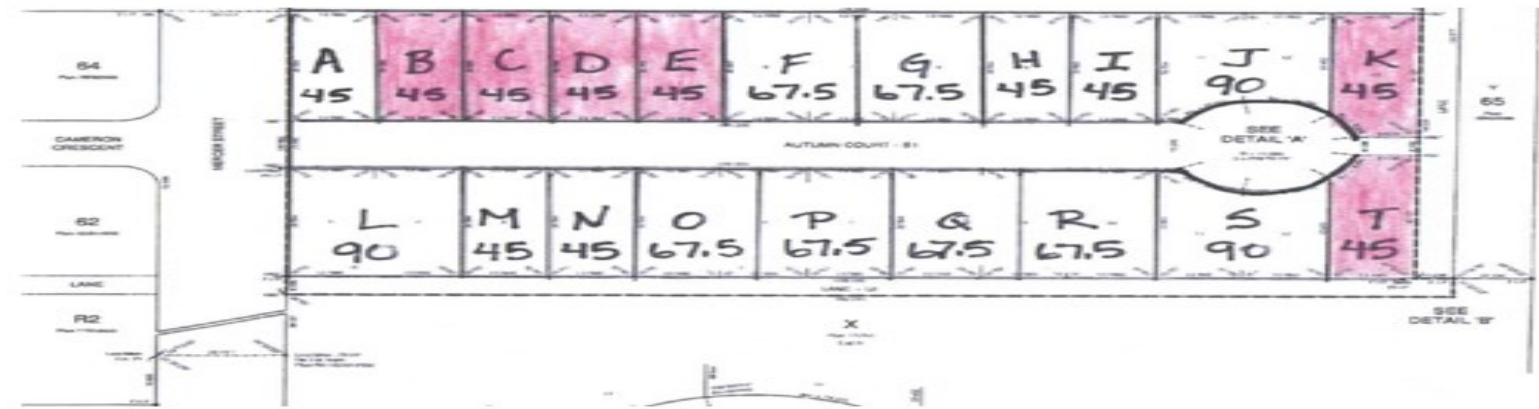
