

Moving forward without moving out

Accessing your home equity can help boost your retirement income, ease pressure on your pensions and investments, and help you stay put.

In a recent survey of Canadian homeowners, only four in 10 respondents were confident they would have enough savings to maintain their lifestyle when they retire. One reason maybe that, for many, a significant portion of their wealth at retirement is tied up in their home. And selling their house to free up that money simply isn't what they want to do.

If that sounds like your situation, you may want to consider accessing the equity in your home to help boost your retirement income. One of the most common ways to do this is through a secure line of credit (also called a home equity line of credit). A secured line of credit lets you borrow what you need, when you need it, at a very favorable interest rate because your loan is secured, or guaranteed by your home.

- Your withdrawals are tax-free unlike withdrawals from registered accounts such as Registered Retirement Saving Plans and Registered Retirement Income Funds.

- You can ensure ready availability of funds to meet unexpected home or health care expenses.

- You can reduce the cost of other debts by transferring those balances to the secured line of credit (if the interest rate is lower than your other loans)

Keeping in mind that you may need to have enough cash flow from other sources to cover the monthly interest payments on the secured line of credit. To protect yourself and keep interest costs

from becoming a burden, it's a good idea to put a cap on the amount you borrow—for example, 20 percent of the value of your home.

Your home is an important asset that should figure in your overall retirement planning. Speak with your Advisor to find out how well this approach fits your personal situation.
