

Accessing your home equity can help boost your retirement income, ease pressure on your pensions and investments, and help you stay put.

In a recent survey of Canadian homeowners. only four in 10 respondents were confident they would have enough savings to maintain their lifestyle when they retire. One reason maybe that, for many, a significant portion their wealth of at retirement is tied up in their home. And selling their house to free up that money simply isn't what they want to do

A secured line of credit lets you borrow what you need, when you need it, at a very favorable interest rate because vour loan is secured, or guaranteed by your home.
